2018 PLAYER REGISTRATION FACT SHEET

Registration fees for the upcoming 2018 winter season have now been set. Your Club's Committee have carried out a comprehensive review of income and expenditure as part of the developing the Club's budget to determine player registration fees for 2018.

One of the most significant changes to the Club financial situation has been the requirement to register for GST.

South Hobart Football Club is a non-profit, community based sporting club that relies predominantly on registration fees, sponsorship, canteen sales, fundraising and NPL game entry fees as its primary sources of revenue.

Our primary expenses include:

- Team Registration and licence fees, Match Official (Referee) fees, ground hire (training and matches).
- Equipment – (balls and nets etc), team and coach uniforms.
- Coaching, insurance, physiotherapy and first aid supplies.
- Lighting, electricity, internet, trophies and food supplies.




Figure 1: Percentage breakdown of SHFC Expenses for 2018.

We have sought to limit the increase in fees as much as possible while seeking to maintain the Club's high standards and professionalism.

The table below outlines the registration fees for season 2018:

Age	2018 Fee
Junior U6 to U7 years	\$113.00
Junior U8 to U12 years	\$234.00
Youth U13 to U16 years	\$393.00
U17 to U18 years	\$498.00
Seniors (men & women)	\$498.00
Social Leagues	\$416.50

REFUND POLICY

Refunds are available on the Club component of the fee in the event of extenuating circumstances – such as a serious season ending injury or interstate relocation. The FFT/FFA component of the fee is not refundable as the Club merely collects and passes that onto FFT/FFA. Refunds are NOT available when a player changes their mind about playing for the Club.
